

The powers and duties of Boards of Education are derived from the State Constitution and the laws of New York State, particularly the Education Law. In addition to those powers and duties expressly set forth in the law, Boards have a broad grant of authority as implied in state law to take such action as is necessary for the conduct of the school system.
