

The Board believes that the legislation of policies is its most important function and that the execution of those policies is the function of the Superintendent. The Superintendent, as chief executive officer, is responsible for the professional leadership and skill necessary to translate the will of the Board into administrative action.

The Superintendent is responsible for all aspects of school operation. Responsibility and authority may be delegated to others as necessary to ensure efficient operation of the schools. Regulations issued by the Superintendent to carry out the provisions of Board policy shall become a part of this Board policy manual.

The Board assumes that the Superintendent is professionally able and possesses outstanding qualities of leadership, vision, and administrative skill, and that the Superintendent will extend courtesy and respect to the Board and implement all policies in good faith. The Superintendent is expected to keep the Board informed about the school operation.

The Superintendent can assume that the Board will respect the Superintendent's professional competence and will extend their courtesy and support of the Superintendent's decisions and administration of the school district.
