

The Board does not encourage the presence on school property of any fraternity, sorority, or secret society where admittance to membership is decided by the current members rather than the free choice of any pupil.

The Board will abolish or prohibit any fraternity, sorority or other secret society in the secondary schools of the district if such society by virtue of its activities creates any interference with the academic process of the school or academic progress of any student within the school.

Staff members shall report any interference of the academic process or progress by any fraternity, sorority or secret society to the building principal. The principal shall conduct an appropriate investigation and issue his or her findings together with a recommendation to the Superintendent. The Superintendent shall then make a recommendation for Board action.
