

DO NOT RESUSCITATE ORDERS AND
OTHER SPECIAL MEDICAL ORDERS

5422

The district, from time to time, may receive "DO NOT RESUSCITATE" orders regarding particular students. Such orders will always be "nonhospital" DNR orders.

When a life-threatening situation occurs for any student, district staff members will intervene only until emergency medical personnel arrive.

As soon as possible after receiving a nonhospital DNR order, the superintendent or his/her designee will respond to the parent/guardian, explaining this policy and advising them to send the DNR order to their physician and/or the most likely emergency response squad in the village or town.
