

Education should be a pleasant and rewarding experience for every student. It is normal and expected that rules must be established to secure an environment within which each student is treated fairly and equally and is able to pursue his or her education free from physical and psychological harm.

Each principal is required to ensure that all policies and regulations pertaining to supervision of students are understood by the students and staff and are properly administered. Principals shall establish additional rules as deemed necessary to guarantee the proper supervision of students in his or her building and such rules may be subject to approval by the Superintendent.

The Board of Education holds all school personnel--any adult with the responsibility of supervising students in any capacity--responsible for the proper conduct and control of the students under the legal supervision of the school and supports all school personnel acting within the framework of this policy.

Parents and guardians share fully in the responsibilities of student supervision and are expected to support all school regulations. If parents or guardians are concerned about any school related supervision of their child, they are expected to immediately communicate with the staff member responsible for that supervision.
