

School bus scheduling and routing shall be guided by these criteria:

1. Maximum attention shall be given to the safety of students who ride the buses and to the drivers who operate them.
2. Students shall arrive at school and leave school according to a time schedule approved annually by the superintendent.
3. Every effort shall be made to limit a student's travel time to school or from school to home to a maximum of one hour each way.
4. When practical transfers may be made from one bus to another.
5. Students shall be supervised from the time they enter the bus for the trip to school until they depart from the bus to go to their home.
6. Children shall not be put off the bus except in an emergency, until reaching their destination.
7. Routes shall provide for the efficient and cost effective use of buses within the constraints of this policy.
8. The superintendent/ designee shall establish rules of conduct for students on buses and for procedures to enforce such rules.
