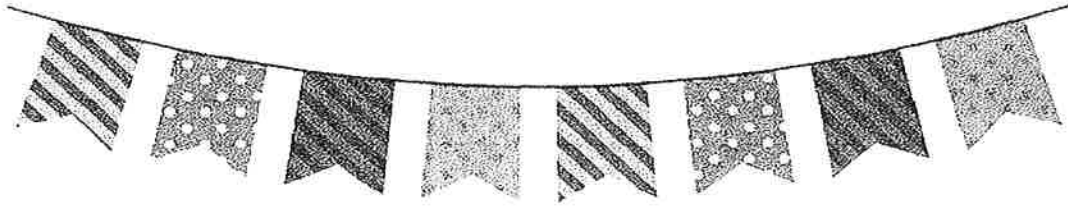


## Mrs. Fisher's 1<sup>st</sup> Grade Supply List
