- an art shirt labeled with your name

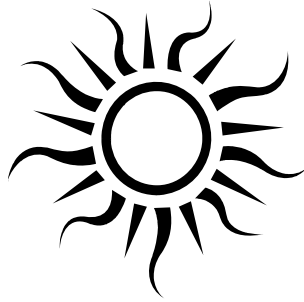
Please do not bring a personal pencil sharpener. You will not need Elmer's glue or a three-ring binder/organizer.

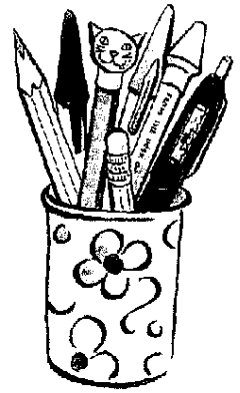
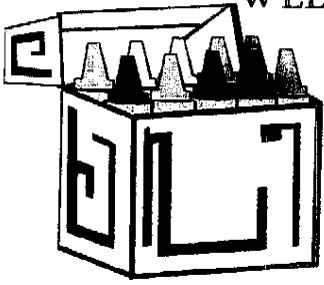
YOUR LIST
