

1. Homebound instruction is a service provided to students who are unable to attend school due to medical, emotional, or disciplinary problems. Secondary students receive instruction for two hours per day and elementary students receive one hour per day. Students receive credit for their work while on homebound instruction. Homebound instruction will not be conducted on those days on which school is not in session.
2. The district makes provisions for homebound instruction, upon referral, following the guidelines established by the Superintendent of Schools/ designee for placing a student on homebound instruction.
