Educational Excellence for a Changing Tomorrow

Johnson City Central School District was given an allocation of **\$1,970,831** through the Smart Schools Bond Act. This Bond Act provides funding for school improvement in up to six major categories: *school connectivity, community connectivity, classroom learning technology, pre-kindergarten classrooms, replacement of transportable classrooms and high tech security*. Our Smart Schools Advisory Team and our Board Facilities Committee determined that Johnson City would benefit most by using the funds to make improvements in the area of high tech security features.

High Tech Security Features:

- Replacement of Security Cameras. **(\$485,751)**
 - Security cameras would be replaced at the following buildings: Johnson City High School, Johnson City Elementary-Middle School, Johnson City Wildcat Stadium and Johnson City Transportation Complex.
 - Stand-alone security recording equipment would be replaced with a networked digital system covering the entire district.
 - Install additional security cameras as needed across all buildings.
- Installation of Voice Over IP (VoIP) Telephone system across the district. **(\$212,253)**
 - The new VoIP system would be used to improve student and teacher safety by providing a VoIP device in every classroom and integrating the devices with emergency communication systems.
 - The Transportation Complex would also be tied in using the same system.
- The remaining dollars **(\$1,272,827)** of our allocation would be used for security upgrades in conjunction with a capital project at the Elementary-Middle School. These include the following item(s):
 - Reconfiguration of the entrances and offices at the Elementary-Middle School to create secure vestibules.
 - Hardening of the main entry doors at the Elementary-Middle School.
